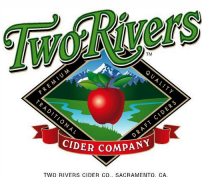

The evening will include:

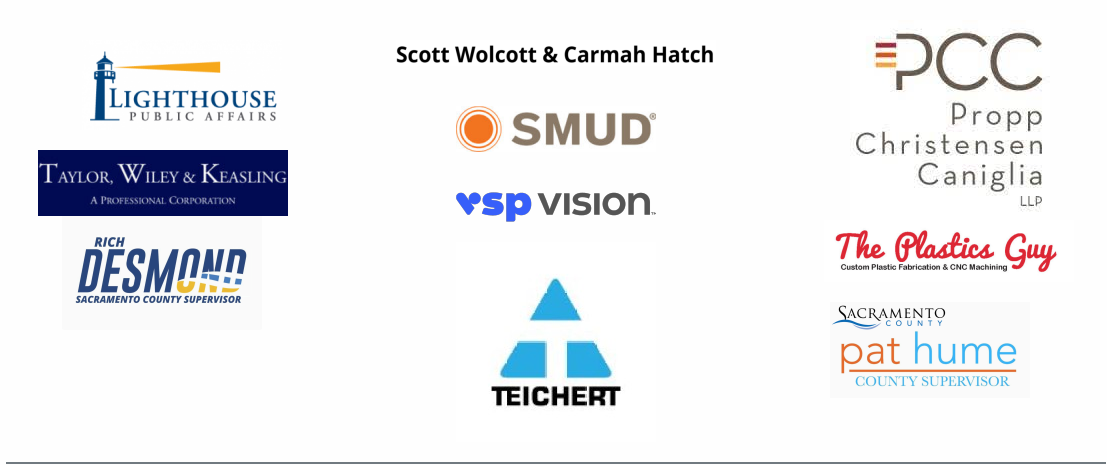
- a delectable, farm-to-fork dinner presented by Mother Restaurant's Robb Vendetti

Tickets are \$325 and are now available for purchase on our website! All ticket and auction proceeds support our education program.

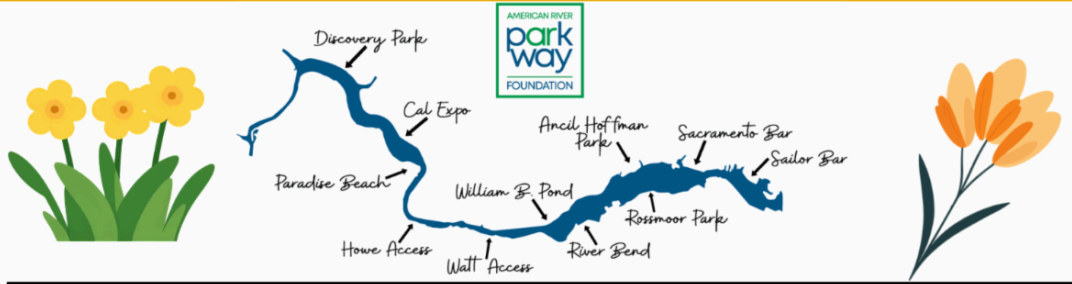

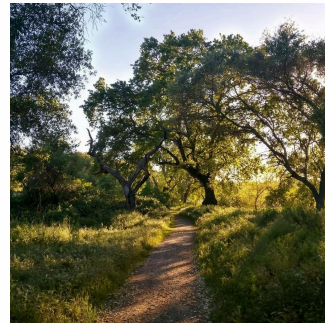
Fund Conservation during Big Day of Giving on May 7!
